

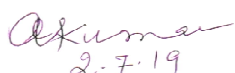
**02.11.2019**

The following resolutions were taken in the meeting:-

1. The proceedings of the last meeting were confirmed.
2. Infrastructure Augmentation and Expansions: The committee members through detailed deliberations enumerated several plans for infrastructural augmentation and expansions and these include:-
  - (i) Vertical expansion of examination halls: As ground floor of the Examination Hall Building has been completed and in the view of requirements, it needs expansion. Therefore, it was resolved that one more storey be added to it. It was decided that the State Govt. of Bihar be approached for release of the required fund and Bihar State Educational Infrastructure Development Corporation (BSEIDC) be asked to initiate the works at the earliest after completing the necessary formalities.
  - (ii) Auditorium: It was resolved that efforts for arranging funds completion of Auditorium be intensified and BSEIDC be asked to expedite the process.
  - (iii) Multipurpose Building:- As per announcement of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Bihar, the work for construction of multi-storey multipurpose building be started at the earliest.
  - (iv) Construction of New Boundary Wall around the college: many members pointed out that the boundary wall around the college is in dilapidated state at several points and in wake of 6 lane road being developed on south-western side of the college, a new boundary wall be constructed which should have greater height. It was resolved that after arranging the requisite fund, a new boundary wall be constructed.
  - (v) Development of Additional Computer Lab in B.Sc. (IT): It was pointed out that one more computer lab is needed in B.Sc. (IT). It was decided that an additional computer lab with necessary infrastructure be created in B.Sc. (IT) and at least 20-25 new computers be procured for it.
3. Faculty Empowerment: The committee members had deliberate discussions on strategies meant for faculty empowerment and mooted a number of proposals:
  - (i) In case of dire emergency and pressing
4. Student Empowerment: Student Development Program (SDPs) on various popular and relevant topics in Science, Social Sciences, Humanities like Instrumentation, Machine Learning, Statistical Analysis, Research Methodologies in scientific and Social Sciences etc. be organised for benefit of students as a part of multifaceted endeavours to provide comprehensive education.
5. Seminar / Workshops: It was resolved that in addition to S.N. Sinha Memorial Lecture Series, Seminar / Workshops on popular, relevant and contemporary topics be held by the organising committee / departments on regular basis.
6. Strengthening of Research: All members in one voice emphasis on strengthening augmenting expanding and intensifying the research activities. The following decisions were taken:
  - (i) Efforts for acquisition of new projects from various funding agencies be intensified. Teachers especially young teachers who intend to expand their research bases should be assisted by experienced senior teachers having strong research profile. Fence sitters should also be encouraged to acquire more projects with the help of senior teachers. Young researchers should be provided requisite infrastructure and institutional support for carrying out research work.

- (ii) Senior teachers should guide young teachers in implementing various protocols for research application.
  - (iii) The Central Instrumentation facility be further strengthened.
  - (iv) The college International Office should be strive for acquiring international projects, increasing international collaborations, exchange programs and student internship.
  - (v) Adequate attention be given to strength researches in Social Sciences and humanities.
  - (vi) PIs, CO PIs should be granted more autonomy and incentives for carrying out researches. Funds should be released on time to maintain project implementation time line.
  - (vii) Meritorious final year students be involved in funded research projects to gain research experience.
7. Extension and Outreach Activities: It was resolved that NSS and NCC activities towards amelioration of society will be intensified. They will be geared up to meet emergency7 situations in the society. Various social issues, mass cleanliness, environmental sustainability etc. will be addressed by NSS and NCC volunteers. It was also resolved that from researches directed towards solving societal problems like Arsenic and fluoride contamination in drinking water, the society should be immensely benefited. In this way the laboratory should be extended to local population.
8. Environmental Awareness and Green Initiatives: It was decided that programs related to environmental awareness and environmental sustainability be intensified. The college should observe events like Earth Day, Prithwi Diwas and should also participate in “Jal Jeevan and Hariyali” program of Govt. of Bihar. For providing boost to the Green initiatives by intensifying plantations of trees, especially Neem trees and other useful plants. Rain Water harvesting and Waste management should be promoted.
9. MIS and RFID: It was resolved that for automation of office requisite steps like floating of tenders be initiated for procuring College management Information System. Similarly, tenders should be floated for introducing Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) in the Central Library.
10. Placement and Guidance Cell, Korean language Centre and language labs: After detailed discussion, it was resolved that for intensifying placement, career counselling and guidance, the “Placemwent and Guidance Cell” be transferred to Shatabdi Bhawan, where MCA, BCA BBm and MBA are located and Dr. Ratna Amrit should be made Incharge. Similarly, Korean language Centre and language Lab be shifted from Boys Hostel which is being demolished for construction of Multipurpose Building to Shatabdi Block.
11. Feed-Back Analysis
